Leaving Edmonds: We would suggest catching one of the following ferries: 7:50am, 8:50am, 9:40am, 10:30am or the 11:10am

Leaving Kingston: Assuming we play 5+ hour tournament round and a 1pm shot-gun start leaving Kingston the ferry schedule is as follows: 7:00pm, 7:45pm, 8:25pm, 9:10pm, 10pm, 11pm and 12:25am.

Contest Holes

We will have 4 contest holes during the course of the tournament. We will have 2 long drive competitions and 2 KP competitions. See below for the details. Prizes for these competitions will be presented at the end of the tournament.

Front 9

KP: Hole #6 – Hit the Green Contest

Players have the option to pay \$5.00 at the hole for contest play. If you hit the green, you automatically win a sleeve of golf balls. If you hit it inside the circle (10ft) on the green, you automatically win a dozen balls. If you get a “hole in one,” you get a set of clubs of your choice.

Proceeds will then be presented to the Circle of Hope on behalf of White Horse in the form a check. This is the course’s way of helping add to our fundraising efforts and something they feel very strongly about at White Horse.

LD: Hole #8 – Grip It & Rip It longest ball of the tee wins. Not required to be in the fairway.

Back 9

KP: Hole #13 – Standard KP

LD: Hole #18 – Straightest & Longest Drive

Post Tournament

- There will be prizes for 1st, 2nd, 3rd and last place.
- Prizes will be presented after all scorecards are turned in and scores are tallied.
- There will be front and back nine KP and LD contests with prizes.
